

## So Now What?

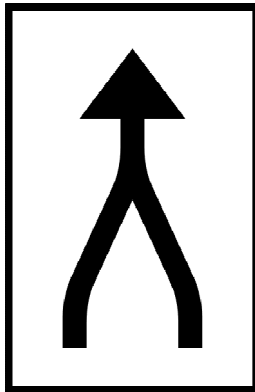
We invite you to look over the various small groups that are meeting at FBC and think about where you might fit in.

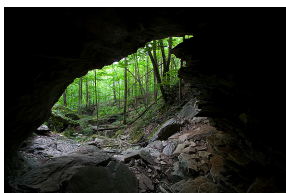
